

**MINUTES OF UPPER RAWCLIFFE WITH TARNACRE PARISH  
COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 14 JULY 2021**

The meeting opened at 7.30pm. The Chairman welcomed those present.

**103/01 Apologies:** Cllr A Thompson; Cllr M Salter of LCC

**103/02 Declaration of interest.** Members were reminded of the requirement to declare any direct or indirect pecuniary or other interests in accordance with the code of conduct and of the requirement to update the register as necessary.

**103/03 Minutes** - It was **RESOLVED** that the minutes of the previous meeting be approved as a correct record.

**103/04 Open Forum:** Noted that the resurfacing of Blackpool Road was to commence on 19 July, with overnight road closures. It was noted that an advertising banner that had been the subject of two planning enforcements had reappeared and that a further complaint had been made to the Planning Authority.

The PC had been approached by the School to site an advertising banner on the mini-roundabout. It was noted that this would be a planning issue under the remit of Wyre Council.

An enquiry had been received about HGV vibration surveys in the Village. The Clerk to forward to LCC.

**103/05 Highways:** Cllr Salter of LCC had submitted the following report:

*As regards the blocked drain opposite Rawcliffe Road, it has been cleared but LCC are to do a final check ahead of the resurfacing next week. LCC are also dealing with possible damage by United Utilities to one of the concrete rafts.*

Noted that there was another blocked drain opposite the telephone box on Blackpool Road.
